GENERAL RULES & NOTES

- The 2-meter rule is not in effect.
- OUT OF BOUNDS: OB areas (including water) are primarily defined by a white painted line or white string/rope. Where present, white stakes serve as a visual aid for OB lines. Where fencing is used, the inside edge of the fence posts is the OB line. Where present, string on playing surface denotes the OB line, and the elevated rope serves as a visual aid. As is standard, the line itself is considered OB. (806.02)
- OB WATER: For any OB water that is not marked with a painted line or rope, a disc coming to rest surrounded by water is considered OB.
- Ad walls that are parallel to an OB line DO NOT serve as the OB line. The OB line will be defined by a painted line running in front of and parallel to the walls. The minimum distance between the walls and OB line is 1 meter.
- DROP ZONES: Optional Drop Zones (DZ)
 may be provided on holes for tee shots
 that come to rest OB. Unless otherwise
 specified, players may re-throw from
 their previous lie (tee), from where the
 disc was last inbounds, OR from the Drop
 Zone. One penalty throw is assessed no
 matter which option is chosen.
- OB RULE RESTRICTIONS: Where noted,
 Drop Zone use may be required after an OB throw, or a player's standard options after going OB may be restricted. PDGA rules waivers have been obtained for these holes, and are marked accordingly.
- MANDATORIES: Mandatory Routes are played according to PDGA Rule 804.01. An arrow will be affixed to an object defining the left or right boundary of the

restricted plane by pointing to the side of the object opposite the restricted plane. The restricted plane continues away from the marked object, as indicated by an orange painted line, and continues in the same direction of the line to infinity. The restricted plane extends vertically from the painted line to infinity bounded by vertical planes on each edge of the line. If part of a thrown disc clearly enters into a restricted plane in play for the hole, the player receives one penalty throw. The lie for the next throw is the **DROP ZONE for that MANDATORY, unless** otherwise noted. In the case that a Drop Zone is located more than 10 m from the mandatory object, a PDGA rules waiver has been obtained.

- RELIEF: Players may obtain relief backward on the line of play, without penalty, from temporarily placed advertising assets, permanent sign posts, or fairway markers, per PDGA Rule 803.02 (A). As the rule states, "unless greater relief is announced by the Director" instead of only taking the closest lie that provides relief, the Tournament Director has granted up to Im relief from the aforementioned assets/obstacles.
- CASUAL OBSTACLES: Per rule 803.01 (B) (1), "A casual obstacle is ... any item as designated by the Director," spectator stakes and ropes that are in-bounds have been designated as casual obstacles, and may be moved and replaced if they impede a player's stance. NOTE: Visual aid ropes used in conjunction with OB string are NOT casual obstacles.
- CASUAL AREAS: Players may obtain relief from unmarked casual water per PDGA

- Rule 806.03. Areas marked with orange paint are designated as casual areas.
- Per PDGA waiver, players are responsible for friends or family who are spectators and who attempt to join the playing group in violation of CM 3.05.G. Players will receive courtesy violation penalties under 812.C if this occurs.
- In the event of a tie for first place after four rounds of play, a winner will be determined by sudden death playoff on holes 17 and 18 repeating until a winner is determined.

HOLE-SPECIFIC NOTES

HOLE 1 PDGA APPROVED GODEN

OB: On or over the parking lot or pavement; Disc surrounded by water.

MANDATORY: Discs must not enter restricted plane right of marked tree.

DROP ZONE: Go to drop zone with one penalty throw for all throws from tee or drop zone that come to rest in the OB lake or miss the mandatory.

NOTE: Rocks on shoreline are in-bounds. Players my take 1 meter perpendicular relief from the rocks as if they were OB.

HOLE 2

OB: On or over pavement/gravel road or outside of roped area; Disc surrounded by water.

NOTE: Rocks on shoreline are in-bounds. Players my take 1 meter perpendicular relief from the rocks as if they were OB.

HOLE 3

OB: On or over pavement left; Roped area right and long of basket and beyond.

HOLE 4

OB: On or over path to the right.

MANDATORY: Discs must not enter restricted plane right of marked tree. If MANDO is missed, proceed to DZ +1 penalty throw.

HOLE 5 PDGA APPROVED GOGPT

OB: Baseball field and outside of the roped area.

DROP ZONE: For throws from the tee area that come to rest OB, the next lie is restricted to either the drop zone or tee with a one throw penalty.

HOLE 6

OB: Discs coming to rest outside the roped area.

HOLE 7

OB: In or over creek left; On or over pavement right.

NOTE: Players may take 2 meters relief from creek.

HOLE 8

OB: Creek area marked by rope; Disc surrounded by water; Over the creek to the left or right near the green; On or over the road/roped line or parking lot to the right.

DROP ZONE: After any throw coming to rest OB, player may proceed to DZ +1 penalty throw. Standard OB rules apply.

HOLE 9 PDGA APPROVED DGPT

OB: Outside of the roped area (including the bridge).

DROP ZONE: For throws from the tee area that come to rest OB, the next lie is restricted to either the drop zone or tee with a one throw penalty.

HOLE 10

OB: Discs coming to rest outside of the roped area.

HOLE 11

OB: Discs coming to rest outside of the roped area.

HOLE 12 PDGA APPROVED GODEN

OB: Outside of the roped area.

DROP ZONE: For throws from the tee area that come to rest OB, the next lie is restricted to either the drop zone or tee with a one throw penalty.

NOTE: Players may take up to 30 cm (approx. 1 ft.) perpendicular relief from the water tower base.

HOLE 13 PDGA APPROVED DGPT

OB: Disc surrounded by water; Outside of the roped area (including the land by the tee).

DROP ZONE: For throws from the tee area that come to rest OB, the next lie is restricted to either the drop zone or tee with a one throw penalty.

NOTE: Rocks on shoreline are in-bounds. Players my take I meter perpendicular relief from the rocks as if they were OB.

HOLE 14

OB: Disc surrounded by water; Outside the roped area; On or across the walking path.

NOTE: Rocks on shoreline are in-bounds. Players my take I meter perpendicular relief from the rocks as if they were OB. For discs coming to rest within casual area marked by orange paint, players may take free relief on the line of play, no closer to the target to the nearest point behind the painted area.

HOLE 15

OB: Outside of the roped area;. On/over pavement.

MANDATORY: Discs must not enter restricted plane right of marked pole. If MANDO is missed, proceed to DZ +1 penalty throw.

NOTE: Players may take up to 30 cm (approx. 1 ft.) perpendicular relief from the cement base of the outhouse.

HOLE 16

OB: Outside of roped area; On or over road.

MANDATORY: Discs must not enter

restricted plane right of marked pole. If MANDO is missed, proceed to DZ +1 penalty throw.

NOTE: Bike path is NOT OB on this hole.

HOLE 17 PDGA APPROVED GIDGPT

OB: Disc surrounded by water and outside of the roped/string area; Pier.

DROP ZONE: For throws from the tee area that come to rest OB, the next lie is restricted to either the drop zone or tee with a one throw penalty.

HOLE 18 PEGA APPROVED GOGPT

OB: Disc surrounded by water; On or over pavement or outside of roped area.

MANDATORY: Discs must not enter restricted plane right of marked tree. If MANDO is missed, re-throw from the previous lie WITHOUT a penalty throw (only counting the throw that missed the MANDO).

NOTE: For discs coming to rest within casual area marked by orange paint, players may take free relief on the line of play, no closer to the target to the nearest point behind the painted area.
